



## Summit Health Terms and Conditions

When you sign up for text messages from Summit Health, you are signing up to receive text messages related to your relationship with Summit Health including updates related to your visits, Summit Health MyChart account, one-time passcode, billing notifications, prescription reminders, and care management.

To opt in to receiving text messages from Summit health, text START to Summit Health's Short Code.

In order to receive text messages, your mobile number must be opted-in and communication preferences must be set for text messaging. Access Communication Preferences via your Summit MyChart account through the account settings and choose which type of notifications to receive and by which method (phone call, text, email, MyChart push notifications).

You can opt-out of SMS messages by texting STOP to Summit Health's Short Code. Your opt-out request will generate one final message confirming that you have been unsubscribed. You will no longer receive SMS messages from the Summit Health's Short Code you opted out from. If you want to join again, sign up using Summit Health MyChart or text HELP to the short code for instructions.

If you are experiencing issues with the messaging program you can reply with the keyword HELP for more assistance, or you can get help directly at 541-382-2811.
